He moved to Worcester, Massachusetts from Vermont by C/1850 and then to Hartland after his marriage to Julia although he was in Worcester working in C/1860 without her. They had a home on Outer
Pleasant Street just past Ireland Cemetery. He operated R. E. Latty & Son Hardware in the 1880s located at the former Linn Woolen Mill Storage Building next to the Hartland Drug Store on Main Street. By
C/1910, they moved in with their son Edward and his family on Main Street where Julia passed away in 1911 followed by Robert in 1913.

E. Latty Hardware Company. He soon sold the business to*

new Latty Block operating as the E. E. Latty Hardware Company. He soon sold the business to Clyde H. Smith and began working as a carpenter for various companies including the railroad and for the American Woolen Company in C/1920. The Hartland Post Office was moved in 1922 into the Latty Block where he was still living with his daughter Mildred with both of them working as a Postal Clerks in C/1930 and remained living there until his death. He operated a Tydol Gas Station on Pittsfield Avenue in the early 1930s which he had been operating up until the time of his death. He was active in numerous town affairs serving as a Town Selectman, Hartland Academy Trustee and on the Hartland School Committee.

Following the death of her father in 1939, Mildred took over ownership of the Latty Block before marrying Raymond in 1943 when he moved in with her.*
