Lloyd spent his youth in Dexter where he began his schooling while living with his maternal Grandmother Minnie and her 2nd husband Joshua Gray in C/1920. They moved to St Albans by C/1930 before moving to Hartland. He worked at L. H. Barden's Store while attending Hartland Academy where he graduated in the Class of 1927. He was Post Master of Hartland in 1934 & 1938. After returning from WWII, he opened and operated Cookson's Market for the next 25 years with his first store located in the Davis & Webber Block at Warren Square in 1947 before moving to the Hartland Drug Store Block in 1951. In 1957, he purchased Cooper's Market at the former Walter E. M. Seekins Block on Commercial Street. Vivian, as was her mother, was a hairdresser for 60 years

operating as Vivian's Beauty Salon at their Upper Commercial Street house. Vivian was living with her son Lloyd Jr at the time of her death. Vivian's brother Earle Merrow married Valti McDougal. (See McDougal Family)
