As Caleb Johnson notes on his website, "George came on the Mayflower as a servant to the Edward Winslow family, indicating he was under 25 years old at the time, however he did sign the Mayflower Compact, suggesting he was over 18. This puts his birth year at around 1595-1602. This matches well with his marriage date of around 1625 at Plymouth as by the May 1627 Division of Cattle, he was married to Mary Beckett, and they had had one son, Zachariah. George and family moved to Duxbury very early on, and he was a deputy to the Plymouth Court for a number of years beginning in 1642. He had volunteered for the Pequot War of 1637, but Plymouth's troops were not needed. He was on various committees, juries, and survey teams, during his life in Duxbury. In 1646, for example, he was appointed to the committee to deal with Duxbury's problem of the disorderly smoking of tobacco. George made out his Will on August 11, 1677, and added a codicil to it on September 20, 1677. The codicil is quite interesting as it gives a little insight into a family squabble between siblings John and Patience."

"If my son John Soule above-named or his heirs or assigns or any of them shall at any time disturb my daughter Patience or her heirs or assigns or any of them in peaceable possession or enjoyment of the lands I have given her at Nemasket alias Middleboro and recover the same from her or her heirs or assigns or any of them; that then my gift to my son John Soule shall be void; and that then my will is my daughter Patience shall have all my lands at Duxbury and she shall be my sole executrix of this my last will and testament and enter into my housing lands and meadows at Duxbury."

George & Mary had 9 known children; Zachariah, **John**, Nathaniel, George, Susanna, Mary, Elizabeth, Patience and Benjamin Soule.

Thomas Lothrop's Regiment on 9 Dec 1776 and a Corporal in Captain Calvin Partridge's Company under Col. Abijah Stearns's Regiment on 1 Apr 1778. He was discharged 2 July 1778. Ruth remarried in 1806 in New Gloucester to James Russell.

They were living in Halifax, Massachusetts after they married before moving to Mount Vernon around 1794. The History of Garland notes William Soule was living in Garland by about 1820 and settled at the Parkman Neighborhood south of the pond with multiple family members including Gideon, John and David. They were still living in Garland in C/1840 but were living in Hartland at the time of his death in 1849 as noted in the C/1850 Addendum of Deaths. Rachel was living with her son David in Hartland in C/1850 noted at 82yrs old.
