THOMAS ROBINSON, son of Jonathan and Mercy (Chase), was born in Stratham, N. H., Sept. 18, 1753. He lived in Epping, N. H., during war service and in Pembroke from 1780. In his application for pension in 1818 he stated that he enlisted from Epping in Oct., 1776, for one year as a private under Capt. Mark Wiggin, Col. Peirce Long, N. H. troops; was appointed ensign in same company in December; left the army in October, 1777; was on the retreat from Ticonderoga, at the battle of Stillwater, and at the taking of Burgoyne. The same service is recorded in N. H. Revolutionary Rolls.

He married in May, 1779, Mary (or Molly) Wilson, and they had children, the first eight born in Pembroke: Thomas; Polly, married a Dickey; John Wilson, became a sea-captain at Wiscasset; Winthrop; Charlotte, married Dudley Swain and lived Skowhegan; Bradbury, lived Cornville; Peter, went to Wisconsin; Jonathan, Palmyra; Betsey, married a Pratt, Bangor; Louisa, married a Dudley, Bangor.

Ensign Robinson came to Maine about the turn of the century, probably with all his family. Thomas Sr. and Thomas Jr. were living in Cornville in 1801. Between 1805 and 1812 both Thomases moved to farms in the present Skowhegan on the road from the Kennebec to Malbons Mills, early named Wesserunsett Road, but from their name often called Robinson Road. Both farms went to the line of the Mile Strip, Thomas Jr's. on the west side between the road and the Stream, and Thomas Sr's. east of the road. These were Robinson farms for many years, Thomas Jr. succeeding to his father's ownership. The Ensign was a U. S. pensioner and his widow received a pension. Thomas Robinson died in Skowhegan, Apr. 22, 1839, and Molly Robinson Sept. 5, 1848; both are buried in Malbons Mills Cemetery. Stratham and Pembroke, N. H. VR. NHW. USP. Deeds Wiscasset and Augusta.
