

Jeremiah Goodridge/Goodrich Family

The family surname is noted as Goodridge on numerous early documents through 1850 and then often as Goodrich with various family members using both spellings during their lives on documents from 1860 forward. For format purposes of this document, the Goodrich surname is used below unless otherwise noted for the 2nd Generation of descendants of Jeremiah Goodridge, Sr.

*“The first of the name of Goodridge to come to Canaan were four brothers, David, Samuel, Jonathan, and **Jeremiah**, who came from Brunswick about 1790. They all reared large families except David, and their descendants are very numerous in the town today. The brothers cleared farms near the Clinton line, in the south part of the town.” ~ Canaan Historical Society*

Following the accidental death of her father in 1843 and the subsequent death of her mother in 1846, Ellen and her younger brother lived with her maternal aunt and her husband, George & Elizabeth (Welch) Jackson in West Hartland until she married. They lived in Palmyra with their homestead straddling the Palmyra/Hartland town line on Pittsfield Avenue across from the future Pine Grove Cemetery where they remained their entire lives. In 1886, the newly built Sebasticook & Moosehead Railroad crossed Pittsfield Avenue on their property in 1886 and became a Flag Stop known as 'Goodrich Crossing'.
